It was further AGREED that the issuing of the Notice be delayed until after the appeal against the refusal of planning permission has been decided. In the event that the planning appeal is allowed and planning permission is granted for the change of use to a single dwelling house, the Notice should not be served.

It was further AGREED to grant the Planning Manager delegated authority to finalize the wording of the Notice.
