**Addendum – Council – 03/03/2022 - Community governance review of the unparished area of Taunton and adjoining parishes – results of first stage consultation and draft recommendations**

**1. Recommendation 2.2 A (v) currently reads:**

*(v) The area covered by the Maidenbrook Ward of Cheddon Fitzpaine Parish Council, including several sites earmarked for housing development in the near future, be included within the boundary of the proposed new Taunton Parish.*

To be more precise and to avoid any future confusion it is proposed to refine the recommendation further to aid in clarifying that it is not the totality of the Maidenbrook Ward that is proposed to be included;

*(v) The **urban** area covered **by within** the Maidenbrook Ward of Cheddon Fitzpaine Parish Council, including several sites earmarked for housing development in the near future, be included within the boundary of the proposed new Taunton Parish. (Refer to Appendix A on Pg.31 and Pg.44 in Appendix B for the map).*

**2. At 9.62 in the Covering Report – Projected Electorate of remainder of Staplegrove Parish in 2027**

The report currently states that is expected that the projected electorate of the remainder of Staplegrove that is not to be included in the proposed Taunton Parish Boundary is less than 150, to be confirmed.

We have now had confirmation from Electoral Services of property figures of 21 and an electorate figure of the area of 37. This is unlikely to fluctuate dramatically in the next five years.
