This financial year.....

- Revenue has exceeded expectations for the six months by £75k.
- Initial Health & Fitness numbers were promising but have recently taken a hit (individual financial pressures/budget gym operator). Later slide.
- Recruitment challenges challenging first 6 months, now settled.
- Utilities impact YTD and full year forecast (£136k at the end of September 22, full year £300k)
- Maintained opening hours and facilities when other providers ryonenfortunately have not.

Both Blackbrook and Wellsprings have been hit with the opening of Pure Gym.

Pure Gym opening - £12.99 (3,000 members as of Feb23).

Pricing review for 2023 – Holding Blackbrook and Wellsprings. Wellington will increase by £2 per month, review ongoing. Need to remain competitive in the current market place.

Price pre-covid membership was £41.99 – now £27.99/£29.99 and £32.49



Health & Safety

- During this period, the number of accidents ratioed against 10,000 visitors for the contract was 1.20, down from previous six-months.
- A male adult swimmer swallowed his tooth plate whilst taking part in an adult's lane swimming session at Wellington Sports Centre.
- This six-month period has seen 72 accidents in total, an increase of one accident when compared to the previous six-months.
- A male gym member who is living with Parkinson's disease fell whilst walking from his car to Wellsprings Leisure Centre, resulting in a facial injury and scuffs to his legs and arm.




Pricing Update – From 1st April 2023

- Due to financial pressures on utilities, suppliers and contractor increases core prices will be increased by 11% from 1st April 2023 (Badminton, swimming, spa, classes etc). Increase in line with inflation at the time of writing.
- Wellington H&F membership will increase by £2.00 per month.
 The H&F membership prices at Blackbrook and Wellsprings will be held and remain under constant review.
- Swimming lessons will increase by £1 per lesson, this will now include all badges & certificates, plus FREE casual swimming.
- Tennis and gymnastics will see a £1 per lesson increase.

Energy/Environmental

- Sites are working hard to focus on "Good Energy Housekeeping"
 - "Energy Champions" nominated at each site.
 - "Turn it off", "Turn it down" approach.
 - Pool temps reduced to 28°c/30°c, Sauna and Steam reviewed.
 - Improvements needed with recycling
- Solar Panels at Blackbrook and Taunton Pool provide a welcome benefit.
- Internal and customer campaigns to reduce carbon
- New LED lighting at Wellsprings and Blackbrook (annual saving of 48 tonnes of carbon emissions)
- New building management system at Wellington greater influence or controls


