## APPENDIX B

## Conditions proposed under the operating schedule and by responsible authorities

## Proposed Operating Schedule – Coffee Couture, Wimbleball Lake, Brompton Regis, Dulverton TA22 9NU:

- The premises must operate a 'Challenge 25 policy', whereby anyone wishing to purchase alcohol, that appears to be under the age of 25 years, must be asked to provide photographic identification e.g. passport, driving licence, PASS card;
- All employees to receive regular training with regards to the legal and social responsibilities of supplying alcohol. This training must be capable of being evidenced;
- 3. A CCTV system must be installed, maintained and used at the premises.
- The licence holder must maintain a refusals register to record instances where the sale of alcohol and proxy sales to a patron is refused. Records must be kept for a minimum of 12 months and must be made available to the Police or authorised officer of the Licensing Authority on request;
- All drinking vessels must be promptly cleared from tables when drinks are finished;
- Noise or vibration will not emanate from the premises such as to cause persons in the neighbourhood to be unreasonably disturbed.
- 7. Suitable signage must be displayed, where practicable, in outside areas requesting patrons to respect the amenities of local and campsite residents.
- 8. Where outside areas are provided for the use of patrons, facilities for the disposing and collecting of litter must be maintained.
- The handling of beer kegs, bottles and other similar items must not take place in the late evening, at night and during the early morning when the noise generated could cause a nuisance.
- 10. Noxious smells from licensed premises must not cause a nuisance to nearby properties.
