Currently, due to roundings, both Scrutiny Committees, Planning and Licensing all have 16 seats rather than 15. Therefore these all need to reduce by 1

In terms of dealing with the rounding issues for the Committees, the following needs to be discussed between the Group Leaders:-

Liberal Democrats:

Prior to the by-elections, the Lib Dems had the following. Corporate Scrutiny Committee – 7 seats Community Scrutiny Committee – 7 seats Planning Committee – 8 seats Licensing Committee – 7 seats

As a result of winning the recent by-elections, the Lib Dems now have one additional seat. The easiest solution is to have 8 seats on the Community Scrutiny Committee as that is the Committee that the Independents previously had their extra seat on.

Conservatives:

At the last allocation the Conservatives had the following: Corporate Scrutiny Committee – 3 Community Scrutiny Committee – 2 Planning Committee – 2 Licensing Committee – 3

Depending on discussions with the Group Leaders this may stay this way. If not the Conservatives will still need to have 2 seats on 2 Committees and 3 seats on the other 2

Independents Group:

Due to the Liberal Democrats winning both by-election seats this means that rather than having 5 seats on the Community Scrutiny Committee, this now reduces to 4. Cllr Wren will need to advise as to which Councillor will be coming off the Committee from the Independent Group Members.

With these changes factored in the allocation would look like the following:
