- 8.3 I understand that failure (without reasonable excuse) to register or disclose ' any disclosable pecuniary interest in accordance with section 30(1) or 31(2) (3) or (7) of the Localism Act 2011I or participating in any discussion or vote in contravention of section 31(4) of the Localism Act 2011I or taking any steps in contravention of section 31(8) of the Localism Act 2011 is a criminal offence and risks a fine not exceeding level 5 on the standard scale (currently £51000) or disqualification as a member for a period not exceeding 5 years.
